TOCAORES

This dish is served in a paella pan. Paella is cooked in a traditional sized paella pan can serve 3-6 people, but you can buy pans that serve over 200 people!

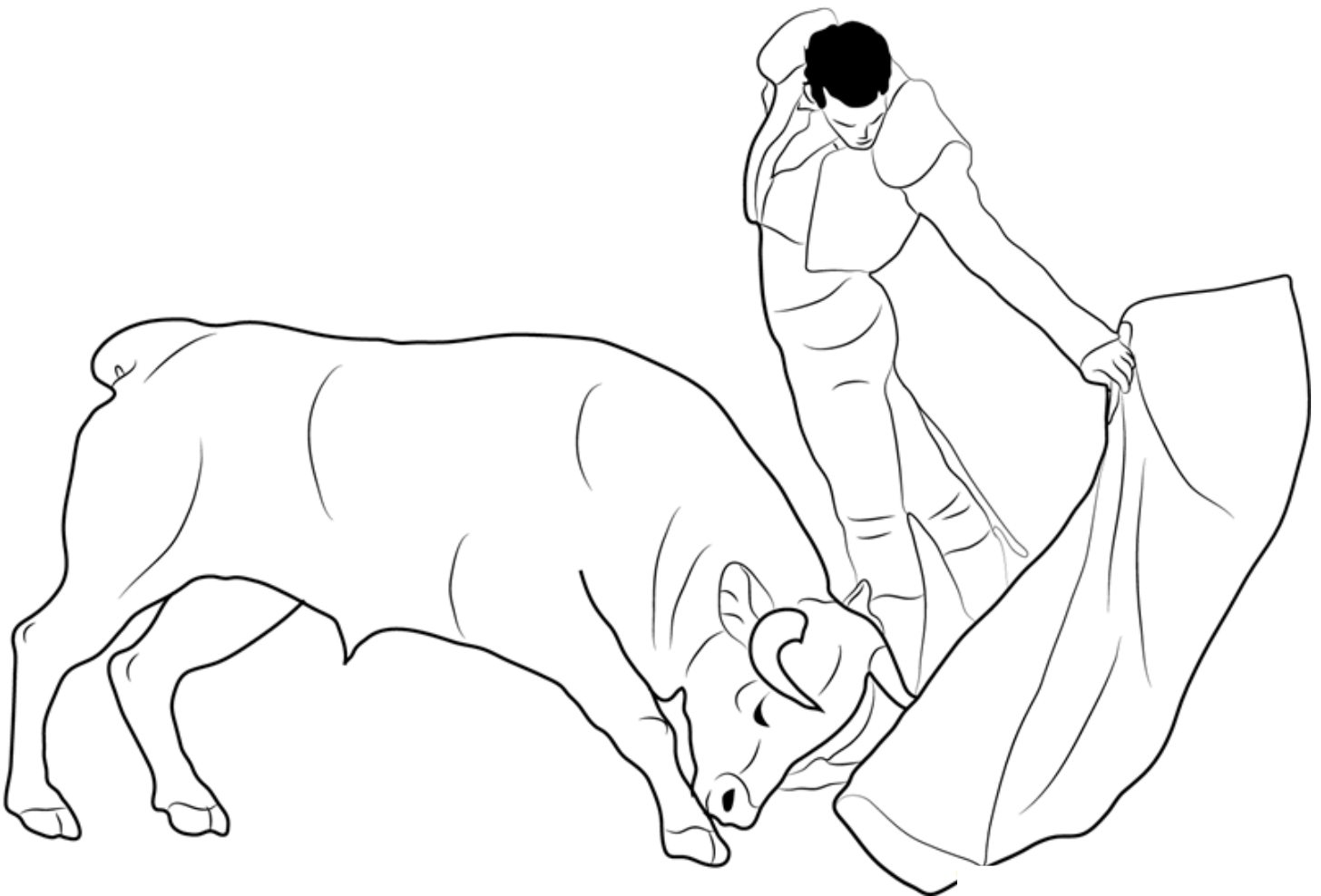
CORRIDA DE TOROS

Corrida de toros is an old Spanish sport called bullfighting.

The bulls are known as toros and the men are matadors.

Matadores dress up in colorful costumes and hold a muleta to attract the toro. The performance with the muleta is called faena.

Corrida de toros is a very dangerous sport. A matador will train for his whole childhood at a special bullfighting school before he even enters the bullfighting ring as an adult.

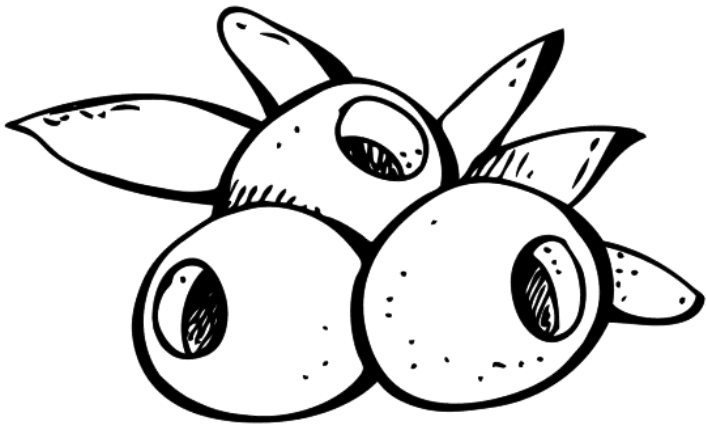




FUTBOL

Cristiano Ronaldo is a famous fútbol player who used to play in Spain. He played for a team called Real Madrid.



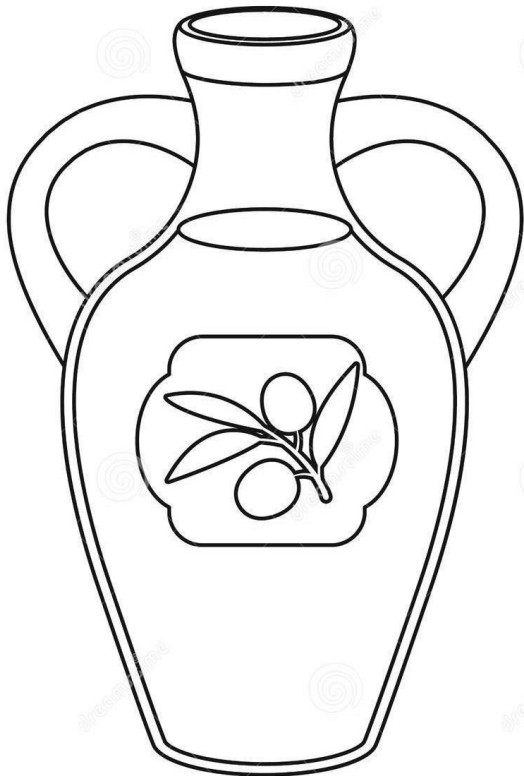
ACEITUNAS

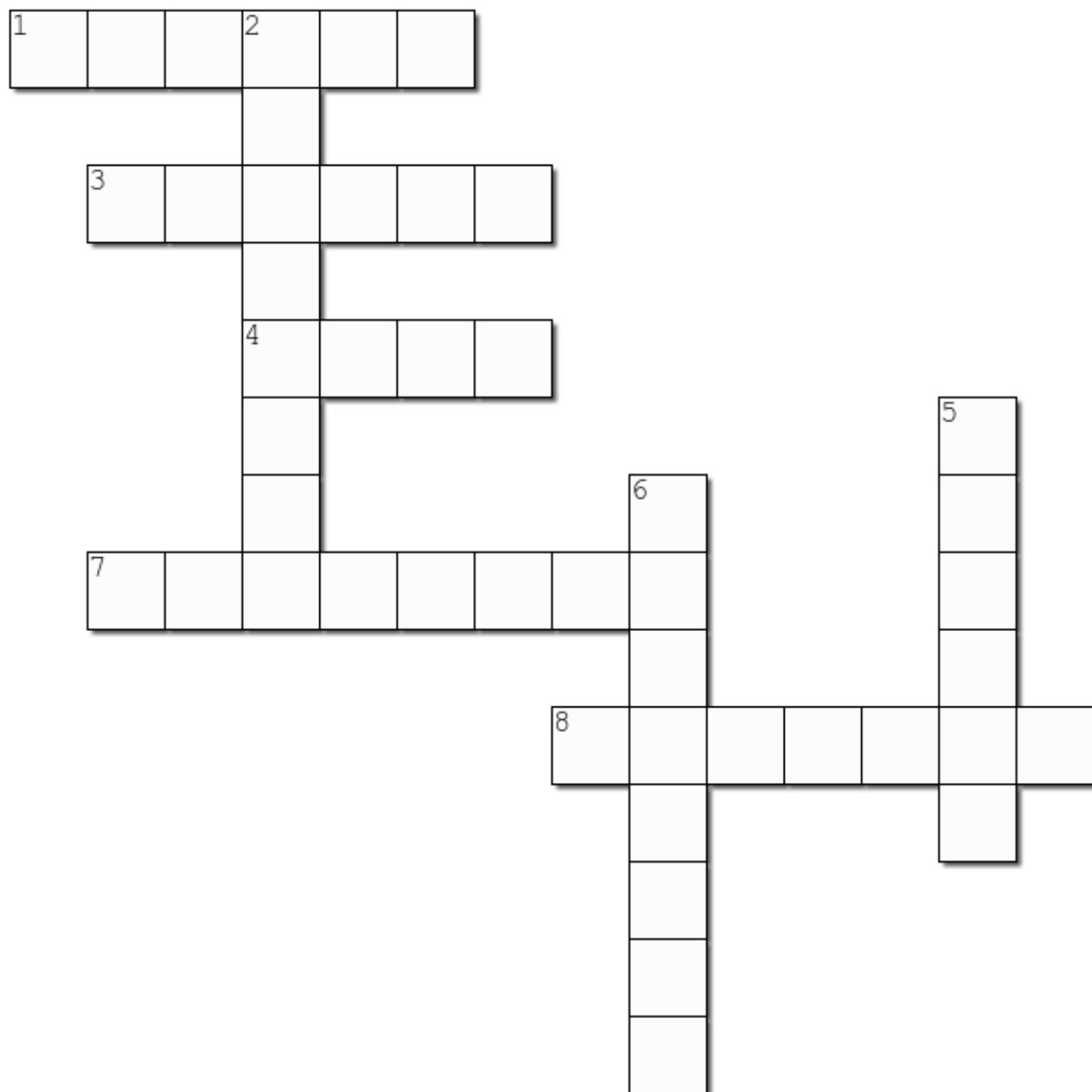
