Sometimes they play fast, and sometimes slow. The dancer claps to the beat of the guitar!


FLAMENCO

Paella is a rice dish that can have meat, fish, seafood, vegetables, or a combination of those ingredients!



CORRIDA DE TOROS

Corrida de toros is an old Spanish sport called bullfighting. The bulls are known as toros and the men are matadors.

<u>Matadores</u> dress up in colorful costumes and hold a <u>muleta</u> to attract the <u>toro</u>. The performance with the <u>muleta</u> is called <u>faena</u>.


Corrida de toros is a very dangerous sport. A <u>matador</u> will train for his whole childhood at a special bullfighting school before he even enters the bullfighting ring as an adult.





<u>Eútbol</u>, known to us as soccer, is the most popular sport in Spain. There are 20 professional <u>fútbol</u> teams in Spain.

Cristiano Ronaldo is a famous <u>fútbol</u> player who used to play in Spain. He played for a team called Real Madrid.




<u>ACEITUNAS</u>


Aceitunas are olives.


